

45-Minute Team Challenge: The Al War Game for SMEs

& Objective

You are the leadership team of a Singapore logistics SME.

Your goal: craft a strategic Al adoption playbook for a six-month pilot project.

You have 45 minutes, working in parallel. Each teammate owns one task.

At the end, you will deliver a **mini board pitch** with 5 outputs:

- Strategic Summary
- Comparison Table
- Executive Memo
- PowerPoint Pitch
- Morale Speech

Background

Your board has approved a **six-month Al pilot**. Success = millions invested to scale adoption.

But you face obstacles:

- Employees fear AI will replace them.
- Managers are confused: tool or threat?
- Competitors boast of AI productivity gains.
- Regulators stress responsible use (IMDA).

Your job: Treat AI rollout as a **campaign of positioning, morale, and decisive action**.

Team Roles & Tasks

Each team member takes one role. Follow the detailed instructions & prompts.



Task A. Strategic Summary (Researcher)

Goal: Summarize and translate *The Art of War* from Mandarin to English and identify 2 comparable frameworks.

Instructions:

- 1. Open ChatGPT (or Deep Research if you prefer citations).
- 2. Copy-paste this prompt:

"Summarize the content from http://www.fang.ece.ufl.edu/artofwar.pdf in English. Your summary should include:

- a. A clear and concise overview of the main message or purpose of the text.
- b. Key takeaways and essential points, presented as bullet points.
- c. Any notable supporting details or examples that help explain the main ideas.
- d. If applicable, highlight the implications, conclusions, or recommendations made in the text."
 - 3. Then prompt:

"Identify 2 similar books or frameworks to *The Art of War* (e.g. *The Prince*, *Blue Ocean Strategy*). For each, provide 1 key lesson relevant to leadership and competition."

Deliverable:

Half-page Word document with summary (Art of War + 2 frameworks).



Task B. Comparison Table (Analyst)

Goal: Create a simple 1-page table comparing the 3 frameworks.

Instructions:

1. Copy-paste into ChatGPT:

"Create a comparison table contrasting The Art of War, The Prince, and Blue Ocean Strategy.

Columns: Power & Control, Risk & Uncertainty, Morale & Human Factors, Positioning & Advantage.

Rows: Each framework.

Output as a Word-ready or PowerPoint-ready table."

2. Ask ChatGPT to also output in **PowerPoint slide layout** (optional).

Deliverable:

• One table (Word or PPT).



Task C. Executive Memo (Consultant)

Goal: Write a 1-page executive memo to the board.

Instructions:

1. Copy-paste into ChatGPT:

"Draft a one-page executive memo to the board of a Singapore SME in the logistics sector.

Structure the memo as follows:

- 1. Objective of the AI pilot (add the context)
- 2. Risks (employee morale, regulatory, competitive pressure)
- 3. Strategic approach (inspired by *The Art of War*, *The Prince*, and *Blue Ocean Strategy*)
- 4. Expected ROI (time saved, productivity gains, competitive positioning)
 Write in a concise, professional board-style tone (bullet points welcome). Limit to one page."

Deliverable:

One-page Word memo.



Task D. PowerPoint Pitch (Communicator)

Goal: Build a 3–4 slide board pitch.

Instructions:

1. Copy-paste into ChatGPT:

"Create a 3-4 slide PowerPoint outline for a board pitch.

Slide 1: The AI Opportunity - why the company must act now

Slide 2: Our Strategy - based on *The Art of War*, *The Prince*, *Blue Ocean Strategy*

Slide 3: Risk Controls - responsible AI (IMDA), morale management

Slide 4: Call to Action - decision required from the board Output in clear bullet point format, ready to paste into PowerPoint."

Deliverable:

• PowerPoint deck (3–4 slides).



Task E. Morale Speech (Leader)

Goal: Inspire employees that AI is a tool, not a threat.

Instructions:

1. Copy-paste into ChatGPT:

"Write a 2-minute motivational speech script for employees of a Singapore SME.

Purpose: reassure them that AI will not replace jobs but empower them.

Tone: inspiring, forward-looking, confident.

Must answer directly the question: 'Will AI replace us?'

Length: about 200 words."

Deliverable:

Script (~200 words).



♣ Surprise Curveball

At minute 25, the facilitator will draw one card:

- im IMDA introduces strict explainability standards
- Kompetitor announces 20% Al-driven cost cut
- B Labor union threatens strike over AI

Task: Each person spends **5 minutes updating their deliverable** to reflect this new reality.



Final Team Presentation (10 minutes)

Each teammate presents their piece:

- 1. Researcher → Strategic Summary
- 2. Analyst → Comparison Table
- 3. Consultant → Memo highlights
- 4. Communicator → PPT board pitch
- 5. Leader → Morale Speech



Judged on:

- Clarity Are outputs concise, professional?
- **Persuasiveness** Would the board approve?
- Adaptability Did you pivot after the crisis?
- Morale Did you inspire employees?
- Framework Use Did you apply Sun Tzu + others?
